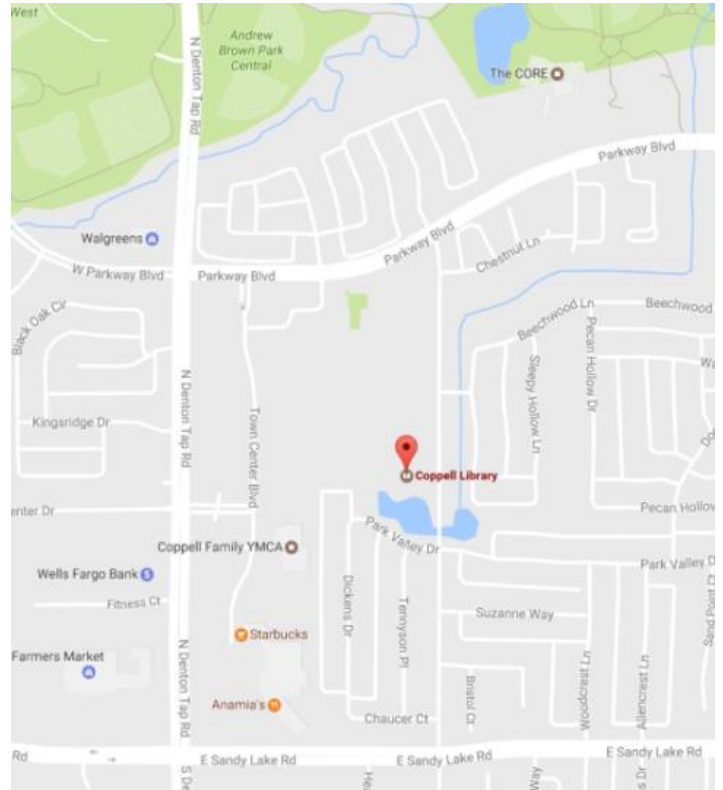

From Central Dallas:

Go North on I-35 to 114. Take 114 to Belt Line Road. Turn right on Belt Line Road. Continue on Belt Line/Denton Tap Road for approximately 5 miles to Sandy Lake Road. Turn right Sandy Lake and then left on North Hartz. The library will be on your left.

From North Dallas:

Go West on I-635 West. Exit on Belt Line Road. Turn right on Belt Line Road. Continue on Belt Line/Denton Tap Road for approximately 5 miles to Sandy Lake Road. Turn right Sandy Lake and then left on North Hartz. The library will be on your left.



From Arlington/MidCities:

From I-20 or I-10 Go north on the President George Bush Turnpike, State Highway 161 North. Take the exit toward Belt Line Road. Turn left on Belt Line Road. Continue on Belt Line for approximately 5 miles to Denton Tap Road. Turn right on Denton Tap and then left on North Hartz. The library will be on your left.
